

This **Introductory Bonsai Course** has been particularly planned for students who have had no experience in this fascinating living horticultural art form. The aesthetic appreciation and fundamentals of Classical Bonsai Art are taught in the four week course. Major emphasis will be on the theory and techniques of bonsai design, pruning, wiring and potting. Each lesson consists of a slide lecture, demonstration and workshop where students are encouraged and assisted in creating their own bonsai. Four bonsai will be created by each student by the end of the course.

Instructor for this course is William N. Valavanis, professional bonsai artist, educator and scholar. He has combined his two horticultural degrees and over sixty year intense bonsai study and passion to develop dynamic educational programs which he freely shares with organizations on five continents. He is the publisher and editor of *International BONSAI*, a well recognized magazine distributed around the globe.

The **Introductory Bonsai Course** will be held on four Monday evenings from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. All classes will be held at the International Bonsai Arboretum, 1070 Martin Road, West Henrietta, New York, home of the Valavanis Bonsai Collection. Developed bonsai as well as trees in training can be studied in this unique garden. An area map will be sent with confirmation.
